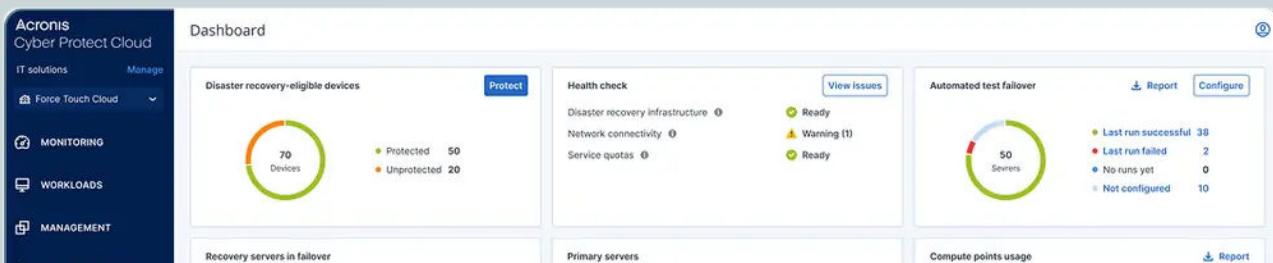

01	Rank critical services	Identify the systems that must return first during ransomware, outage, or site disruption.
02	Map dependencies	Confirm application, identity, network, storage, and user access dependencies.
03	Prepare recovery paths	Match each priority workload to backup restore, cloud recovery, failover, or staged restoration.
04	Validate readiness	Run a recovery check or tabletop review so decision makers understand the sequence.
05	Keep it current	Review changes, test results, runbook gaps, and open actions on a recurring cadence.

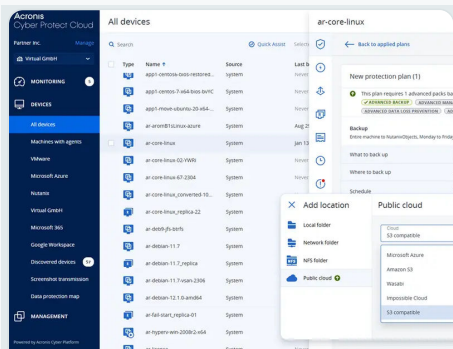

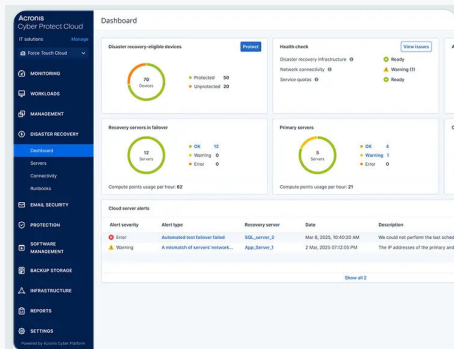

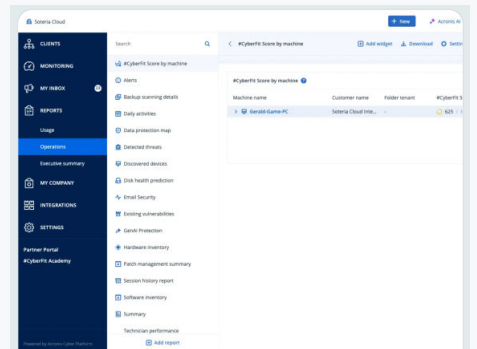
